If the Council decides at any time that on the ground of expense or otherwise it necessary or advisable to discontinue the use of the Village Hall in whole or in part for the purposes stated herein it shall call a meeting of the inhabitants of the age of 18 years or upwards of the area of benefit of which meeting not less than 14 days notice (stating the terms of the resolution that will be proposed there at) shall be posted in a conspicuous place or places on the Village Hall and advertised in a newspaper circulating in the area of benefit and if such decision shall be confirmed by three quarters of such and voting at inhabitants present meeting the Council may with the consent of the Charity Commissioners or the Secretary of State let or sell the Village Hall or any part thereof. All monies arising from such letting sale (after the satisfaction of liabilities properly payable there out) shall with such consent as aforesaid be applied in the purchase of other property approved by the Council and to be held upon the trusts for the purposes and subject to the provisions hereinbefore set forth (including thereto as near as power) or this
